Introduction

This archive consists of publications of Australian and New Zealand Association for Medieval and Early Modern Studies.




Medieval and Renaissance studies used to be an integral part of the programme in most Humanities disciplines. In the 1960s, as universities expanded in size and number, and academics gained more international contacts, New Zealand and Australian colleagues sought closer association. The University of Sydney's Medieval Studies Group, to which New Zealand colleagues belonged by correspondence and received the regular Newsletters, was the launching pad for the Australian and New Zealand Association for Medieval and Renaissance Studies (1967-), which became in 1996 the Australian and New Zealand Association for Medieval and Early Modern Studies, with significantly increased representation of historians. The Association holds regular conferences. From the outset it has published a Bulletin, which from December 1971, became the journal 'Parergon', with a New Series beginning in 1983. The first ANZAMRS conference held in New Zealand was organised jointly by colleagues of Massey University and Victoria University of Wellington, and took place at Massey University, Palmerston North, in February 1975.
