He became an Assistant Lecturer in Agricultural Zoology in 1933/1934 and in 1934 completed a M.Agr.Sc. at Massey. In 1951 he obtained a D.Sc. at MAC. In the late 1940s he was promoted to Associate Professor and served as Head of the Department of Agricultural Zoology until 1962.
